Our award submission highlighted many of the unique programs that have been implemented at the HHS Hospitals in Halton Hills, Milton and Oakville. The Hospital was presented with the award at the Ontario Hospital Association’s HealthAchieve Conference held in Toronto.

“We are thrilled with the recognition that has been awarded to the staff at HHS who have all contributed to the successful achievement of this Gold award,” said Karen Adams, HHS Vice-President, People and Organizational Development.

The panel of quality workplace experts recognized a number of the unique programs that have been implemented at HHS including the availability of staff fitness centres at all HHS hospitals, the Kailo Wellness Program and the Interprofessional Mentorship, Preceptorship and Coaching Team (IMPACT), which exposed frontline staff to new perspectives in patient centred care and interprofessional collaboration. HHS was also congratulated for organizing annual patient safety expos which provide staff with opportunities to showcase and be recognized for their good work. The 2010 Patient Safety Expos were open to the public this year.

HHS was additionally recognized for having a strong commitment to quality improvement and quality workplace initiative metrics and evaluation processes.
